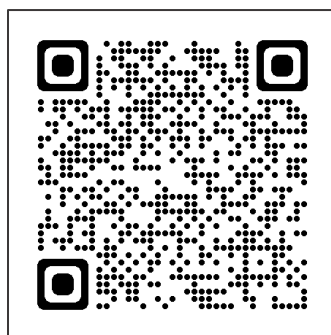

Maison Gardet has been producing champagne since 1895, maintaining the quality and character of its wines year after year through a combination of traditional and modern wine-making methods.

Composed of 90% Pinot Noir and 10% Chardonnay, House of Commons Brut is an exceptional honey gold champagne with a full-bodied consistency that has balance and length.

The House of Commons Vintage English sparkling wine has been aged in the cellars for seven years prior to release and shows a personality which combines Digby's signature English freshness with a deep, rich complexity and long finish. It all comes with a bottle design honouring the first wine bottle in modern times, which was invented by Sir Kenelm Digby.

The first vines were planted in 1973, when local wine retailer Alan McKechnie started harvesting the vines on his small fruit farm. With a little help from the 1976 record summer temperatures and bumper harvest, his small fruit farm begun to expand. Under the ownership of John Oldacre the vineyards flourished and the name was changed from Fairfield Fruit Farms to Three Choirs Vineyards due largely to John’s connections to the Three Choirs Festival, England’s oldest choral festival.

A crisp, refreshing wine with distinctly English hedgerow aromas and hints of crisp apple, fragrant elderflower and freshly cut grass. The ripe fruit flavours, balanced acidity and subtle residual sugar combine to create a refreshing wine, perfect on its own or with fish dishes.

This 2019 vintage Bordeaux from Chateau La Tuilerie du Puy is a fresh but complex wine, with appealing red and black fruits on the nose and an excellent length of flavour finished with refined tannins. It is well balanced, medium bodied, and holds its own alongside robust dishes such as Beef Wellington.
